

CHEAT SHEET: HOW TO PLAN A BUDGET FOR YOUR NEXT EPIC TRIP

Not sure how much you need to save for your next trip? Here's the process I use to budget and plan for each trip I take.

1. Visit www.budgetyourtrip.com

This site is AWESOME. It takes real life travel expenses recorded by actual travellers, and aggregates them to calculate averages for every destination.

2. Search for the country or city you're planning on visiting

Once you enter in your intended destination, you'll see estimated daily travel costs per person for that region. These are constantly refreshed and you can see the date of the latest update right on the page. Categories include accommodation, local transport, food, entertainment, tours, and even scams and mishaps! They don't, however, include visas or international transport..

3. Narrow it down by travel style

You can dig deeper and refine those costs further to get a more accurate prediction. There are options to break them down into budget, mid-range, and luxury style travel. Boom.
